The project began in 1977, and in 1981, the first versions of AutoCAD and MicroStation were released. It was a part of the first commercially released, general-purpose, desktop CAD system. Adoption of AutoCAD was immediate. Designers and engineers used the new system to create the first CAD models. It was the first commercially available CAD system for the desktop. Later on, in 1987, the program was converted into a Windows-based version and the names changed to AutoCAD and MicroStation.
