Before AutoCAD Serial Key, the industry standard for architectural CAD was the widely used general-purpose drafting program called Archicad. Archicad could be used for CAD work, but it was mainly used for drafting-only tasks. AutoCAD was intended to be used for design and drafting tasks, and to be more accurate than Archicad, which had many drawbacks. AutoCAD is the most popular CAD software in the world, with over 200 million users in nearly 200 countries. In 2006, Gartner ranked AutoCAD as the world's top selling software application for the third consecutive year. AutoCAD has a significant following of designers, architects, engineers, technical illustrators, drafters and 3D modelers. Over its history, AutoCAD has featured major improvements in object modeling and editing, enhanced capabilities of the command line and the graphic user interface, industry-standard database access, native support for 3D printing, AI/deep learning capabilities, and integration with other 3D modeling programs. History AutoCAD was first introduced in 1982 as AutoDraft on the MacIntosh series of computers. AutoDraft was designed to be a more reliable and user-friendly CAD program than Archicad. In 1988, AutoCAD was ported to other platforms, including the PC, DOS and some UNIX operating systems. AutoCAD LT was developed in 1991 as a low-cost solution for smaller companies and designers. AutoCAD was included in the AutoCAD LT package until AutoCAD LT 2010, when AutoCAD 2010 replaced AutoCAD LT 2010. In 1995, AutoCAD continued to be released for use on other platforms, such as the Macintosh OS 8.5 and Macintosh OS 9, and the Windows operating system. In 2004, Autodesk released AutoCAD LT 2004, which allowed for the importation of formats from previous versions of AutoCAD. The following year, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD 2007, and it introduced many new features. The AutoCAD platform, along with AutoCAD LT, was also made available for mobile and web use, and some of the features and capabilities of the desktop software were also incorporated into mobile and web apps. In 2010, AutoCAD LT 2010 was released. It incorporated many features of AutoCAD 2010, including the introduction of floating line tools. The First World War: The Great War Memorial Project The First World War: The Great War Memorial Project (GMMWPP) was founded in 2003 by historian Stephen A. Nutt, and is the only ongoing project to raise money for an existing war memorial to commemorate all those who died in the First World War. Origins The original idea of the project was conceived by Nutt when he was working as the education officer for The National Memorial Arboretum. He saw the lack of a monument to remember those who died in the First World War and realized that it was of great importance to commemorate all those who fought in the war, whether they were members of the British armed forces or not. Nutt aimed to raise £1 million to commission a design for a First World War memorial to be erected at the Arboretum. The project came to the attention of the then Prime Minister Tony Blair and, after being supported by the Royal British Legion and the Department for Communities and Local Government, the project was launched in 2003. In the following years Nutt negotiated a deal with Leicester City Council and it was agreed that a memorial would be erected in Market Square. Campaign The Campaign for Great War Memorials has been the driving force behind the fundraising campaign. In June 2003 the campaign launched a fundraising appeal with the Daily Telegraph, the Sunday Telegraph and the Manchester Evening News. The appeal was backed by Prime Minister Tony Blair and The Prince of Wales. Over
